Second to None

Rev. 2:12-17

Jesus identifies himself as (2:12, 16):

The one with the “sharp, double-edged sword”

“I know...” (2:13):

Where you live – where Satan has His throne.

Commendation (2:13):

- 1) “you remain true to my name”
- 2) “you did not renounce your faith in Me...” (even when some were being martyred)

Reproof or correction (2:14-15):

- 1) “You have there some who hold the teachings of Balaam”
- 2) “eating food sacrificed to idols” (Acts 15:29)
- 3) “committing sexual immorality”
- 4) “some who hold to the teachings of the Nicolaitans”

Instructions (2:16):

“Repent! Otherwise I will soon come to you”

Promise to those who overcome (2:17) I will give:

- 1) “some of the hidden manna”
- 2) “a white stone”
- 3) “a new name”

There is no room for compromise if we follow Jesus. (Matt. 6:24)
