Joy in our Challenges *Phil. 1:12-20*

- "Joy is the resilient contentment that remains no matter what." Hab. 3:17-18
- *Our joy is not found in c<u>ircumstances</u> that change, but in the God who does not c<u>hange</u>.*

How can I have *joy* in the middle of my difficulties?

- 1) P<u>erspective</u> (v. 12)
 - Keep our eyes on our purpose (v. 12, 20)
 - Look for the positive –
 It is clear throughout the palace guard, this is for Jesus! (v. 13)
 Encouraging to the brothers (v. 14)
 Christ is preached –I rejoice (v. 18)
 And that was Paul's practice while in Philippi. (Acts 16:13-30)
- 2) T<u>rust</u> "what has happened will turn out for my deliverance." (v. 19)

T<u>rust</u> is gathered as faith is t<u>ested</u>.
