### Joy in the Journey

#### Joy in our Challenges

*Phil. 1:12-20*

“Joy is the resilient contentment that remains no matter what.” Hab. 3:17-18

*Our joy is not found in circumstances that change, but in the God who does not change.*

How can I have *joy* in the middle of my difficulties?

#### 1) Perspective (v. 12)

- Keep our eyes on our purpose (v. 12, 20)

- Look for the positive –

It is clear throughout the palace guard, this is for Jesus! (v. 13)

Encouraging to the brothers (v. 14)

Christ is preached – I rejoice (v. 18)

And that was Paul’s practice while in Philippi. (Acts 16:13-30)

2) Trust – “what has happened will turn out for my deliverance.” (v. 19)

Trust is gathered as faith is tested.

What handcuffs *you*?

3) Make a Choice.
